Bill Title: Relating to autologous breast reconstruction.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Department of Consumer and Business Services

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires health insurance carriers to cover autologous breast reconstruction procedures including medically necessary inpatient and outpatient services. This coverage is not subject to cost-sharing for in-network providers. To meet network adequacy requirements, health insurance carriers are to contract with out-of-network providers, as needed, to ensure enrollees can access coverage. When using out-of-network providers for this coverage, health insurance carriers must reimburse providers at no less than that provided to in-network providers.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
