# BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Innovation Council (Oregon InC) is a public-private partnership associated with Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD). Oregon InC guides the implementation of <u>Oregon's 10-Year Innovation Plan</u>, a roadmap for the state's economy. Through this plan, Oregon InC seeks to drive sustainable economic growth, create high wage jobs, and retain people and businesses in the state. It provides funding to accomplish this through a series of programs, including one that funds the <u>Centers of Innovation Excellence (CIEs</u>). The CIEs support the growth and development of Oregon's key industries by catalyzing the commercialization and deployment of new products.
