Bill Title: Relating to missing persons.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Counties, Cities

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to establish and maintain the "Call Your Mom Program" that will permit behavioral health treatment or rehabilitation organizations to exchange messages between missing family members and their parents or guardians. To implement the measure, the authority must develop and maintain a system that allows secure exchanging of messages and assigns personal identification number to each message. OHA must develop program and data management rules.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
