**Bill Title:** Relating to marijuana for medical use; prescribing an effective date.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:** Department of Justice, Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission, Department of Agriculture

## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on the Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC), and the State Department of Agriculture (ODA) to consolidate data regarding medical and adult use cannabis and make the data publicly available on a website. The measure also requires marijuana retail workers to be trained specified subject matters and certified every three years by the OLCC. The measure increases the quarterly distribution to the Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund from \$1.25 million to \$1.5 million per quarter. Additionally, the measure requires a quarterly distribution be allocated to the Oregon Health Authority to pay administrative, inspection and investigation costs associated with the authority's responsibility for marijuana processing sites and medical marijuana dispensaries.
