WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority to expand capacity at the Oregon State Hospital to meet the projected needs. The measure requires the Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator to develop and administer a program to provide guardianship services to defendants who are in the aid and assist process. The measure permits the use of jail-based restoration of fitness to proceed, imposes certain requirements on community restoration, defines "qualifying mental disorder," and expands the kinds of eligible crimes for commitment of a person as an "extremely dangerous person" under ORS 426.701. The measure takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
