SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells the OHA to make grants to certain entities. The Act directs the entities to use the moneys to create behavioral health workforce training programs for high school students. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to award grants to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to establish and implement behavioral health education and training programs for high school students. Requires the local workforce development boards to consult with the authority to establish partnerships with specific entities to administer the programs. Requires the authority to consider recommendations from a statewide organization that represents all local workforce development boards when determining the amount of a grant to award.

Sunsets on January 2, 2029.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
