Measure: SB 695 - A

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SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells OHA and CCOs to make various changes designed to improve maternal and infant health. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.1).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to develop and implement a whole-person maternal health model for medical assistance recipients. Requires coordinated care organizations to partner with Early Learning Hubs and federally qualified health centers in adopting community health improvement plans. Directs the metrics and scoring subcommittee of the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee to consider the need to prioritize equity-focused health outcome and quality measures relating to pregnancy and early childhood.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
