## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act lets the State Board of Massage Therapists post a sign on a massage facility that violates the laws or rules on massage facilities. The Act lets the board charge a bigger fine for some violations. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.5).

Allows the State Board of Massage Therapists to post a placard on the exterior of a massage facility found to have committed specified violations. Increases the civil penalty that the board may impose for violations from \$1,000 to \$5,000. Increases the punishment for the second or subsequent violation of operating a massage facility without a permit or practicing massage therapy without a license. Punishes by a maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

Includes a massage therapist in "public or private official" for purposes of mandatory reporting of abuse.

Becomes operative on January 1, 2026.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
