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Bill Title: Relating to election documents posted on county or city websites; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Secretary of State, Cities, County Clerks

Summary of Fiscal Impact

The total fiscal impact of the measure is indeterminate at this time - see explanatory analysis.

Measure Description

The measure requires local election officials to make certain election documents publicly available on the county or city website within two business days of being received and time stamped. Required posting documents include nominating petitions, declaration of candidacy, withdrawal, certificate of nomination, and other documents required by ORS 249.006.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure has an indeterminate fiscal impact to local governments related to redacting signatures on the specified documents before making them publicly available on city or county websites. Costs will be dependent on if a county outsources Information Technology services, what the rate is, and the volume of candidates who choose to file by collecting petition (signature) sheets that could take significant time to redact.

There is no estimated fiscal impact to the Secretary of State.

Relevant Dates

The measure takes effect on the 91st day after sine die.
