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SUMMARY

Digest: Tells insurers in this state to give more information to DCBS and tells DCBS not to share what they receive from insurers. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.4).

Requires certain carriers that offer health benefit plans in this state to report additional information to the Department of Consumer and Business Services and requires the department to keep this information confidential.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure and requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to maintain confidentially information regarding behavioral health data that is required to be submitted to the department by carriers of health benefit plans.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain information about data reported to the department by specific carriers of health benefit plans related to behavioral health claims, reimbursement rates, benefits and compliance with federal and state laws.
