Bill Title: Relating to respite care; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Human Services, Oregon Health Authority

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to support the development and maintenance of respite care services for caregivers of children or youth and individuals who are less than 26 years of age. The authority must ensure there is sufficient staffing to seek federal approval by January 1, 2026, and provide adequate access to respite care services through community partners.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
