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SUMMARY

Digest: The Act requires the state Medicaid program to provide respite care. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.9).

Requires respite care services to be provided through the state medical assistance program to provide relief to children or youth under the age of 26 who have complex behavioral health needs or an intellectual or developmental disability and to the caregivers of such children or youth.

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to seek any necessary federal approval. Becomes operative on the date that notice of federal approval is received.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
