## SUMMARY

Digest: This Act makes a new exemption from public record disclosure for some data that is collected by OLCC. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.6).

Adds an exemption from public record disclosures for data and electronic records collected by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission regarding the sale of items other than distilled liquor.

## **OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT**

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure data or electronic records collected by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission regarding the sale of items other than distilled liquor by liquor stores.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain access to information contained in data or electronic records collected by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission regarding the sale of items other than distilled liquor by liquor stores.
