Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Secretary of State to create and maintain an online Oregon Rulemaking Information System. The establishment of the information system will require additional positions funding. Additionally, indeterminate impacts to agencies include revision and publication of regulatory materials including internal interpretations of statutes and rules, internal management guidance, tips, explanations, and other resources available online.
