### **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 2169 appropriates \$295,126 General Fund to establish an interagency water reuse team lead by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for the 2025-27 biennium.

## **Summary of Natural Resources Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 2169 declares a state policy to encourage water reuse and to expand opportunities for water reuse in the state in a manner that protects public health and the environment. The bill directs DEQ to establish and lead an interagency water reuse team in collaboration with the Water Resources Department, the Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Department of Agriculture, and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. The bill defines water reuse goals for the interagency water reuse team. The bill requires DEQ, in collaboration with the interagency water reuse team, to submit a report to the legislature, no later than December 15 of each odd-numbered year, that describes the progress toward achieving water reuse development goals.

House Bill 2169 appropriates \$295,126 General Fund and establishes one permanent, full-time Natural Resource Specialist 4 position (1.00 FTE) for DEQ to lead the interagency water reuse team.
