WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Senate Bill 5527 ratifies new and increased fees for providers of services to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, including application and initial and renewal license fees for certain residential facilities and adult foster home providers. The measure has no fiscal impact.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Fulfills the requirements of SB 792 (2022) which required the agency to establish application and certification fees, as well as initial and renewal license fees for residential training homes and facilities, adult foster homes, and other facilities certified by DHS to provide developmental disability services. Fees were approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and have been adopted in agency administrative rule.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Clarifies these fees apply only to providers of developmental disability services.

BACKGROUND:

During the 2022 session, the Legislature passed SB 792 which required the Department of Human Services to establish application and certification fees, as well as initial and renewal license fees for residential training homes and facilities, adult foster homes and other facilities certified by DHS to provide developmental disability services. SB 5527 ratifies new and increased fees pursuant to SB 792 (2022), and which have been approved by the Department of Administrative Services and adopted in agency administrative rule.
