## **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 2922 increases Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$1,450,511 for the Oregon Health Authority to adjust the anticipated expenditure needs of the Oregon Educators Benefit Board (OEBB) and Public Employees Benefit Board (PEBB) for providing coverage for medication approved by the United States Department of Agriculture for the prevention or treatment of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).

## **Summary of Human Services Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 2922 expands coverage of health care plans under PEBB and OEBB to include access to HIV drugs approved by the United States Department of Agriculture. PEBB plans must offer this benefit in member plans beginning January 1, 2026, and OEBB plans must offer this benefit beginning October 1, 2026.

The bill includes an Other Funds expenditure limitation increase of \$767,644 for PEBB and an Other Funds expenditure limitation increase of \$682,867 for OEBB. The total increase is due to the estimated increase in premium costs for health care plans offering access to the prescription drugs required under House Bill 2922.
