#### Summary of Revenue Changes

Senate Bill 504 appropriates \$268,488 General Fund on a one-time basis to the Department of Land Conservation to draft and adopt rules pertaining to shoreline stabilization.

## **Summary of Capital Construction Subcommittee Action**

Senate Bill 504 requires the Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt rules by January 1, 2028, defining and prioritizing nonstructural, nature-based solutions for shoreline stabilization in estuaries, coastal shorelands, and the ocean shore. The rules must emphasize ecologically focused approaches over structural methods and include criteria for habitat, water quality, cultural values, and public access. The Commission and the Department of Land Conservation and Development must consult with state agencies including the Department of State Lands, Department of Transportation, and the Parks and Recreation Department to convene an advisory committee of local officials, tribal representatives, environmental groups, and engineers. The measure prohibits changes to existing rules governing the Department of Transportation projects.

The bill includes a \$268,488 General Fund appropriation on a one-time basis and authorizes one full-time, limited duration Planner 4 position (0.75 FTE) to draft and adopt rules pertaining to shoreline stabilization. In the 2027-29 biennium, additional rulemaking costs are expected to be minimal.
