Summary of Revenue Changes

House Bill 2688 appropriates \$268,664 General Fund to the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) for two positions (1.00 FTE) to provide the resources necessary to implement and administer the bill.

Summary of Capital Construction Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2688 expands the definition of public works for the purpose of applying the prevailing wage rate to include certain types of off-site work that are fabricated, preconstructed, assembled, or constructed according to specifications for public works projects as defined in ORS 279C.800. The expanded requirements apply to contracts entered into on or after July 1, 2026.

The Subcommittee recommended a General Fund appropriation of \$268,664 for one permanent, full-time Operations and Policy Analyst 2 position (0.50 FTE) and one permanent, full-time Compliance Specialist 2 position (0.50 FTE) and services and supplies to implement and administer the bill, for which BOLI anticipates a 53.9% increase in the number of complaints filed related to covered public works projects.
