# **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 2065 increases Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$335,136 for the Public Utility Commission (PUC) for the 2025-27 biennium for work related to interconnection studies for microgrid projects. These costs will be supported by the PUC's annual fee on the revenues of regulated electric, gas, telecommunications, and water/wastewater utilities.

## Summary of Natural Resources Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2065 establishes a process for interconnecting microgrids and community microgrids with the transmission or distribution systems of public utilities. PUC is directed to adopt rules governing how third-party consultants perform interconnection studies for microgrid projects, which is to include addressing potential liability issues and establishing standards utilities must apply when reviewing and deciding on interconnection applications. PUC is also directed to assess whether additional policies are needed for microgrid generators, considering existing rules that already cover interconnection costs, dispute resolution, cost allocation, and utility agreements.

This measure increases PUC's Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$260,136 for one permanent, full-time Utility and Energy Analyst 3 position (0.88 FTE) and position related services and supplies to contribute to the work required by the measure. A one-time Other Funds expenditure limitation increase of \$75,000 for the 2025-27 biennium is also included for services and supplies costs related to legal review during rulemaking.
