SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes some changes to the laws that govern physical therapy in this state. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.1).

Allows a physical therapist to perform dry needling. Directs the Oregon Board of Physical Therapy to adopt rules related to dry needling. Allows a physical therapist to sign and date a certificate for a disabled person parking permit application. Exempts a physical therapist from the requirement to obtain a license to use sonographic equipment if the sonographic equipment is used for physical therapy purposes. Changes membership requirements for members of the board. Requires specified reporters to report a claim against a physical therapist to the board.

Becomes operative on July 1, 2027.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
