

House Bill 2043

Sponsored by Representative NOSSE (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS to grant to Oasis of Praise for real property. (Flesch Readability Score: 84.4).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Oasis of Praise International Ministries to acquire, renovate and rehabilitate real property.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
5 **propriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning**
6 **July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, to be distributed by grant to**
7 **Oasis of Praise International Ministries, a domestic nonprofit corporation, for the purpose**
8 **of acquiring, rehabilitating and renovating real property to be used for the sole purpose of**
9 **providing nonreligious community resources and services.**

10 **(2) Before issuing the grant under this section, the department shall enter into a grant**
11 **agreement with the recipient that prohibits the recipient from using the real property, and**
12 **any proceeds from the disposition of the real property, for religious or sectarian purposes.**

13 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
15 **July 1, 2025.**
