HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2059

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "facilities" insert "; and declaring an emergency".

2	Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'residential treatment facility' has the meaning
4	given that term in ORS 443.400.
5	"(2) The Residential Behavioral Health Capacity Program is established within the
6	Oregon Health Authority to fund behavioral health programs that are determined by the
7	authority to increase residential behavioral health capacity throughout this state. The au-
8	thority shall distribute funding to behavioral health programs that the authority determines,
9	according to the guidelines described in subsection (3) of this section, are likely to have the
10	greatest immediate impact on communities' needs for increased withdrawal management
11	facility, residential treatment facility and psychiatric inpatient facility capacity.
12	"(3) The authority, after soliciting and considering input from regional partners and
13	practitioners, shall develop guidelines for distributing funding to behavioral health programs.
14	The guidelines shall include, but are not limited to, the following factors:
15	"(a) The impact of the behavioral health program on the needs identified in a report that
16	was commissioned by the authority to study statewide needs for residential behavioral health
17	capacity;
18	"(b) The ability of the behavioral health program to quickly put the funding to use, in-
19	cluding the availability of a service provider;
20	"(c) The bed-to-cost ratio of a behavioral health program's proposed project, with priority
21	given to shovel-ready projects;
22	"(d) Geographic equity across this state;
23	"(e) The impact of the behavioral health program on the needs of individuals who have
24	been committed to the authority under ORS 426.130 or committed to a state hospital under
25	ORS 161.327 or 161.370; and
26	"(f) Local community input on proposed projects that will serve the highest need.
27	"SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
28	priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
29	General Fund, the amount of \$90,000,000, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of
30	section 1 of this 2025 Act.
31	"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
32	"SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
33	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
34	July 1, 2025.".

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
