

House Bill 2105

Sponsored by Representative OSBORNE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes a state agency make a report to the legislature on surveys done by the agency. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.6).

Directs a state agency to report to the Legislative Assembly when the agency conducts an external survey.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to surveys conducted by state agencies.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"State agency" means any officer, board, commission, department, division or insti-**
6 **tution in the executive or administrative branch of state government.**

7 (b) **"Survey" means the solicitation of the opinions, experiences or beliefs of a statis-**
8 **tically significant number of persons not employed by the state agency.**

9 (2) **A state agency that conducts a survey shall report in the manner provided in ORS**
10 **192.245 no later than three business days after receiving the results of the survey. The report**
11 **must include:**

12 (a) **The results of the survey; and**

13 (b) **The approximate time when the state agency plans to release the results of the sur-**
14 **vey to the public.**
