SUMMARY

Digest: The Act lets a group have standing in the Oregon Tax Court. (Flesch Readability Score: 88.9).

Provides for standing for an association or organization to seek declaratory relief in the Oregon Tax Court.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to standing in the Oregon Tax Court.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 305.570 (1)(b), an association or organization has**
5 **standing to seek declaratory relief in the Oregon Tax Court if:**

6 **(1) One or more members of the association or organization is adversely affected or**
7 **aggrieved by the subject of the requested declaration;**

8 **(2) The interests that the association or organization seeks to protect are germane to the**
9 **purpose of the association or organization; and**

10 **(3) The nature of the claim and the relief requested do not require that the members of**
11 **the association or organization who are adversely affected or aggrieved participate in the**
12 **proceedings in the Oregon Tax Court.**
