SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that ODOT must study speed bumps. (Flesch Readability Score: 94.3). Requires the Department of Transportation to study the development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to transportation.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed bump markings and shall make a report on its findings.
 - (2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
