House Bill 2157

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that ODOT must study ways to fund the transportation system in this state. The Act says ODOT must report to the JCT. (Flesch Readability Score: 82.4). Directs the Department of Transportation to study issues related to transportation funding and

present the results of the study to the Joint Committee on Transportation.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation funding; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Transportation shall study issues related to funding

5 Oregon's transportation system. The department shall submit a report in the manner pro-

6 vided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the Joint Com-

7 mittee on Transportation no later than September 15, 2026.

- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
- 9 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025
 10 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
