

# House Bill 2159

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Joint Committee on Transportation for Representative Susan McLain, Senator Chris Gorsek)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that ODOT must study speed bumps. (Flesch Readability Score: 94.3).  
Requires the Department of Transportation to study the development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.  
Sunsets January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps**  
5 **to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed**  
6 **bump markings and shall make a report on its findings.**

7 **(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and**  
8 **may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative**  
9 **Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than**  
10 **September 15, 2026.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
