On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
3	"(a) 'Community health worker' has the meaning given that term in ORS 414.025.
4	"(b) 'Emergency medical services provider' has the meaning given that term in ORS
5	682.025.
6	"(c) 'Mobile integrated health care' means a coordinated, patient-centered, evidence-
7	based, holistic model of care using collaborative, interdisciplinary teams to serve patient
8	needs at the most appropriate level of care at a safe location of the patient's convenience.
9	"(d) 'Mobile integrated health care provider' means a licensed, certified or otherwise au-
10	thorized emergency medical services provider, community health worker or other health
11	care provider who provides mobile integrated health care services while acting within the
12	scope of the provider's license, certification or other authorization.
13	"(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall:
14	"(a) Prescribe by rule criteria and qualifications for mobile integrated health care pro-
15	viders to enroll as providers in the state medical assistance program; and
16	"(b) Provide technical support to mobile integrated health care providers and their em-
17	ployers in applying for enrollment.
18	"(3) Nothing in this section expands the health services that are covered under the state
19	medical assistance program.
20	"SECTION 2. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-
21	propriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of
22	the General Fund, the amount of \$, which may be expended for carrying out the pro-
23	visions of section 1 of this 2025 Act.
24	"(2) The authority shall use \$ of the amount appropriated under subsection (1) of
25	this section for the authority's initial implementation and management of the authority's
26	responsibilities under section 1 of this 2025 Act.
27	"SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
29	July 1, 2025.".
