

# House Bill 2245

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Labor and Workplace Standards for Representative Dacia Grayber)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells a state agency to study how the state watches firms that do construction. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Requires the Construction Contractors Board to study construction contractors. Directs the board to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to construction contractors not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Construction Contractors Board.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Construction Contractors Board shall study construction contractors.**  
5 **The board shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**  
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**  
7 **lated to construction contractors no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
