

House Bill 2246

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Labor and Workplace Standards for Representative Dacia Grayber)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would make the Employment Department study how UI law is carried out in this state and file a report of the study with the legislature. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.3).

Requires the Employment Department to study the implementation of unemployment insurance law in Oregon. Directs the department to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to employment no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunset January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Employment Department.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Employment Department shall conduct a study of the implementation**
5 **of unemployment insurance law in Oregon. The department shall submit a report of its**
6 **findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to employment in the**
7 **manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
