## House Bill 2248

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Labor and Workplace Standards for Representative Dacia Grayber)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells BOLI to study matters related to the laws that BOLI enforces. A report will be submitted by September 15 of next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.5).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study matters relating to laws over which the bureau has enforcement authority. Directs the bureau to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Bureau of Labor and Industries.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study matters relating to laws over which the bureau has enforcement authority. The bureau shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
