House Bill 2249

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Labor and Workplace Standards for Representative Dacia Grayber)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes BOLI study and report on matters relating to on-the-job training programs in this state. Tells BOLI to submit a report by September 15 of next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.0).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to conduct a study of matters relating to apprenticeship programs in this state. Directs the bureau to submit findings to interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to apprenticeships.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall conduct a study of matters relat-

5 ing to apprenticeship programs in this state. The bureau shall submit a report in the manner

6 provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim

7 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor no later than Septem-

8 ber 15, 2026.

9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
