SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would stop the use by the state business agency of the dba name "Business Oregon." (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).

[Digest: The Act would have Business Oregon study its role in economic development. The Act would require a report of the study to be turned in next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).]

[Requires the Oregon Business Development Department to study its role in economic development in Oregon. Directs the department to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development no later than September 15, 2026.]
[Sunsets January 2, 2027.]

Directs the Oregon Business Development Department to discontinue doing business under the name "Business Oregon."

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Oregon Business Development Department.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 2 of this 2025 Act.
 - SECTION 2. The Oregon Business Development Department shall:
 - (1) Discontinue registering with the Secretary of State to do business as "Business Oregon"; and
 - (2) Hold itself out and otherwise refer to itself as the "Oregon Business Development Department" or "OBDD" and not as "Business Oregon" in all internal and external communications, publications and other documentation of any kind.
