

House Bill 2332

Sponsored by Representative OWENS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act stops the DEQ from making some air curtain incinerators get a Title V permit. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Prohibits the Department of Environmental Quality from requiring a Title V operating permit for certain air curtain incinerators.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to air curtain incinerators; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 468A.300 to 468A.330.

SECTION 2. The Department of Environmental Quality may not, pursuant to the federal operating permit program established under ORS 468A.315, require an air curtain incinerator to have a Title V operating permit if the air curtain incinerator:

(1) Burns only wood waste, clean lumber or yard waste; and

(2) Is not otherwise required to obtain a Title V operating permit under the Clean Air Act or any regulation of the federal Environmental Protection Agency.

SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
