House Bill 2332

Sponsored by Representative OWENS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act stops the DEQ from making some air curtain incinerators get a Title V permit. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Prohibits the Department of Environmental Quality from requiring a Title V operating permit for certain air curtain incinerators.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to air curtain incinerators; and prescribing an effective date.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 468A.300 to 468A.330.
 - SECTION 2. The Department of Environmental Quality may not, pursuant to the federal operating permit program established under ORS 468A.315, require an air curtain incinerator to have a Title V operating permit if the air curtain incinerator:
 - (1) Burns only wood waste, clean lumber or yard waste; and
 - (2) Is not otherwise required to obtain a Title V operating permit under the Clean Air Act or any regulation of the federal Environmental Protection Agency.
 - SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
