SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes ODVA update the World War II memorial as needed and keep a learning tool. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Requires the Department of Veterans' Affairs to keep the World War II memorial located in the Capitol Mall up to date and maintain an educational tool as part of the memorial.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the World War II memorial located in the Capitol Mall; amending ORS 406.505.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 406.505 is amended to read:
 - 406.505. (1) The World War II memorial constructed in the Capitol Mall in the City of Salem,
- 6 Marion County, is an outright permitted use without taking an exception under ORS 197.732 to the
- statewide land use planning goals or changing the acknowledged comprehensive plan or land use
- 8 regulations of Marion County.

- 9 (2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall:
 - (a) Maintain the finished memorial;
 - (b) Make such modifications as necessary to keep the memorial up to date; and
 - (c) Develop and maintain an accessible educational tool as part of the memorial that provides historical context and information on World War II and the service members and civilians who served during the war, including civilians recognized by the United States Department of Defense for contributing to the defense of Wake Island during the war.
 - (3) Modifications necessary to keep the memorial up to date may include but are not limited to:
 - (a) Adding names of service members who meet the criteria under subsection (4) of this section to the memorial; and
 - (b) Other improvements to the memorial as approved by the Director of Veterans' Affairs.
 - (4)(a) A service member's name may be added to the memorial if military personnel records confirm that the service member was killed in action in World War II and was either born in Oregon, enlisted in Oregon or had established residency in Oregon prior to enlistment.
 - (b) A service member is considered killed in action if the service member died in theater

2	(A) The service member's death was caused by enemy action;
3	(B) The service member died of wounds sustained from enemy action;
4	(C) The service member's death occurred while the service member was a prisoner of
5	war; or
6	(D) The service member became and remained missing in action during World War II
7	combat operations against the enemy during the period from May 27, 1941, to January 31,
8	1946.
