

House Bill 2377

Sponsored by Representative LEVY B (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would require a study of the economic development of ports in Oregon. The Act would require a report to be submitted next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Requires the Oregon Business Development Department to study the economic development of ports in Oregon. Directs the department to submit a report of the study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Relating to ports.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Business Development Department shall conduct a study of the economic development of ports in Oregon. The department shall submit a report of its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
