House Bill 2386

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Gives ODVA the power to make rules to carry out the laws on unclaimed remains of veterans and family. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Provides the Department of Veterans' Affairs with authority to adopt rules to implement the laws concerning the unclaimed remains of veterans, veterans' spouses and dependents and survivors of veterans.

6	carry out the duties under ORS 97.231 to 97.243 in accordance with rules adopted by the De-
7	partment of Veterans' Affairs.
8	(2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may adopt rules to implement the provisions of
9	ORS 97.231 to 97.243.
