

# House Bill 2386

Sponsored by Representative GRAYBER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Gives ODVA the power to make rules to carry out the laws on unclaimed remains of veterans and family. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Provides the Department of Veterans' Affairs with authority to adopt rules to implement the laws concerning the unclaimed remains of veterans, veterans' spouses and dependents and survivors of veterans.

2 Relating to the unclaimed remains of eligible decedents.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 97.231 to 97.243.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A veterans' remains coordinator or county veterans' service officer shall**  
6 **carry out the duties under ORS 97.231 to 97.243 in accordance with rules adopted by the De-**  
7 **partment of Veterans' Affairs.**

8 **(2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may adopt rules to implement the provisions of**  
9 **ORS 97.231 to 97.243.**
