House Bill 2404

Sponsored by Representative LEVY B; Representatives OWENS, SMITH G, Senator NASH (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act tells the State Board of Ed. to make a pilot program to help students access education after high school. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.6).

Requires the State Board of Education, in coordination with Eastern Oregon University, to establish a pilot program to provide resources and support for students to access post-secondary education opportunities.

Directs the Department of Education to submit a report on the pilot program no later than December 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

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Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to student readiness for post-secondary education; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Board of Education, in coordination with Eastern Oregon 5 University, shall develop a pilot program to provide resources and support for students to 6 learn about, apply for and enroll in post-secondary education or training programs. The pilot 7 program shall offer resources and support to students enrolled in grades 6 through 12 in 8 school districts located in eastern Oregon.

9 (2) Resources and support offered under the pilot program may include, but need not be 10 limited to:

11 (a) General information about post-secondary education and training opportunities;

(b) Strategies and resources for researching post-secondary education and training op portunities;

14 (c) Support with applying to a post-secondary institution of education; and

15 (d) Support with applying for financial aid and scholarships.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) No later than December 15, 2026, the Department of Education shall 17 submit a report on the pilot program established under section 1 of this 2025 Act to the in-18 terim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education in the manner provided 19 by ORS 192.245.

20 (2) The report shall include the number of hours of support provided to students under 21 the pilot program and the number of students who participated in the pilot program.

(3) The report may include recommendations for legislation, including recommendations
for expanding the pilot program to additional areas of the state.

24 SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2025 Act are repealed on January 2, 2028.

25 SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,

27 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for distribution to Eastern Oregon

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- 1 University to implement the pilot program established under section 1 of this 2025 Act.
- 2 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025
