SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Allows the head of ODVA to appoint a deputy. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.1). Allows the Director of Veterans' Affairs to appoint a deputy director, subject to approval by the Governor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to the Department of Veterans' Affairs. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Director of Veterans' Affairs, subject to approval by the Governor, may 4 5 appoint a deputy director. The deputy director must be a veteran. The deputy director serves 6 at the pleasure of the director, has full authority to act for the director and is subject to the 7 control of the director. The appointment of the deputy director shall be by written order filed 8 with the Secretary of State.
