

House Bill 2531

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would fund the fire, emergency and police services of the City of Salem. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Appropriates moneys to fund the provision of fire response, emergency medical and law enforcement and public safety services by the City of Salem.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to services provided by the City of Salem; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services**
5 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$14,000,000**
6 **to be distributed in two annual installments of \$7,000,000 to the City of Salem for the purpose**
7 **of funding the provision of fire response, emergency medical and law enforcement and public**
8 **safety services by the city.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
