House Bill 2584

Sponsored by Representative HUDSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Stops a franchisor from charging a fee that was not listed in the contract that created the franchise or shown in the disclosure that under federal law a franchisee must see before buying a franchise. Lets a franchisee sue a person for breaking the law. Lets a state agency issue an order to stop the violation. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.9).

Prohibits a franchisor from imposing upon or collecting from a franchisee a fee that the franchisor did not disclose in the agreement under which the franchisor and franchisee established the franchise or in the disclosure document a franchisor must provide to the franchisee under federal law.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to prohibitions upon fees that franchisors impose upon franchisees.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 650.005 to 4 $\mathbf{5}$ 650.100.

6 SECTION 2. (1) A franchisor may not in any manner or by means of any unilateral 7 change to a franchise impose upon or collect from a franchisee in this state a fee that the 8 franchisor did not disclose in the agreement under which the franchisor and franchisee es-9 tablished the franchise or in the disclosure document a franchisor must provide to the franchisee under 16 C.F.R. part 436, as in effect on the effective date of this 2025 Act. 10

11 (2) A franchisor that violates the provisions of subsection (1) of this section is liable to 12 the franchisee as provided in ORS 650.020 (3) for a violation of ORS 650.020 (1) and the Di-13rector of the Department of Consumer and Business Services may issue an order to cease 14 and desist the violation as provided in ORS 650.055 (4).

15 SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to franchises into which a franchisor and franchisee enter or that a franchisor and franchisee renew on or after the effective date of 16 17 this 2025 Act.

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
