## House Bill 2598

Sponsored by Representative RUIZ, Senator FREDERICK; Senator PHAM K (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes clear that a light rail car or monorail are not commercial motor vehicles. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Clarifies that a rail fixed guideway system is not a commercial motor vehicle for the purposes of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to rail fixed guideway public transportation system; amending ORS 801.208.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 801.208 is amended to read:

5 801.208. (1) "Commercial motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle or combination of motor vehicles

6 and one or more vehicles that:

7 (a) Has a gross combination weight rating or gross combination weight of 26,001 pounds or 8 more, whichever is greater, inclusive of one or more towed units, with a gross vehicle weight rating 9 or gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 pounds, whichever is greater;

10 (b) Has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of 26,001 pounds or more;

11 (c) Is designed to transport 16 or more persons, including the driver; or

12 (d) Is of any size and is used in the transportation of hazardous materials.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the term "commercial motor vehicle" does not
include the following:

15 (a) An emergency fire vehicle being operated by firefighters as defined in ORS 652.050;

(b) Emergency vehicles being operated by qualified emergency service volunteers as defined in
ORS 401.358;

18 (c) A motor home used to transport or house, for nonbusiness purposes, the operator or the 19 operator's family members or personal possessions; [or]

20 (d) A recreational vehicle that is operated solely for personal use[.]; or

(e) A rail fixed guideway public transportation system operated by a mass transit district
created under ORS chapter 267.
