

A-Engrossed House Bill 2673

Ordered by the House April 7
Including House Amendments dated April 7

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Education *[to establish an accreditation]* for a **statewide education** program for school business professionals.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to school business professionals; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$800,000, which may be distributed to the Oregon Association**
7 **of School Business Officials for the development of a statewide education program that pro-**
8 **vides training and ongoing professional development in public school financial administration**
9 **for school business officials and school district administrators who support the work of**
10 **school business officials.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2025.**
