

House Bill 2675

Sponsored by Representative MCINTIRE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Provides money for an after-school program at OIT. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2).
Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Oregon Institute of Technology for an after-school program.
Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding for an after-school program at the Oregon Institute of Technology; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
7 **2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$802,835, for distribution to the Oregon Insti-**
8 **tute of Technology to provide an after-school program that provides opportunities for**
9 **structured social skills, physical activity and academic assistance for the children of faculty,**
10 **staff and students of the Oregon Institute of Technology.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2025.**
