

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2688

By COMMITTEE ON LABOR AND WORKPLACE STANDARDS

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 44 and 45.

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:

3 “(G) Bespoke, off-site fabrication, preconstruction, assembly or construction work performed
4 specifically for, and in accordance with the specifications of, a particular project of a type listed in
5 subparagraphs (A) to (F) of this paragraph, for the following systems:

6 “(i) Mechanical systems such as heating, ventilation, air conditioning, refrigeration and other
7 ducting or piping systems or components;

8 “(ii) Plumbing systems or components;

9 “(iii) Electrical systems or components of electrical systems that conform with the requirements
10 of ORS 479.510 to 479.945 and the rules of the Electrical and Elevator Board;

11 “(iv) Boiler systems or components of boiler systems;

12 “(v) Ornamental and structural iron work;

13 “(vi) Masonry and plaster systems or components;

14 “(vii) Roofing, flashing and architectural panel systems or components other than glazing sys-
15 tems and components; and

16 “(viii) Mechanical insulation work.”.

17 In line 27, delete “January” and insert “July”.

18 Delete lines 28 through 35 and insert:

19 “(2)(a) The Attorney General, the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,
20 the Director of Transportation and a contracting agency that adopts rules under ORS 279A.065 or
21 279A.070 may adopt rules and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection
22 (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the Attorney General, the directors or the contracting
23 agency to undertake and exercise all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the Attorney
24 General, the directors or the contracting agency by the amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1
25 of this 2025 Act.

26 “(b) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall adopt rules that, among
27 other items, specify which manufacturing and which standard inventory items are excluded from the
28 definition of public works and the requirements for reporting off-site work, and may take any other
29 action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable
30 the commissioner to undertake and exercise all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the
31 commissioner by the amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1 of this 2025 Act.”.
