House Bill 2721

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would allow a city or county to impose a public transit surcharge on top of any parking fine. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.8).

Authorizes a city or county to impose a public transit incentive surcharge on the amount of any fine for violation of the city's or county's motor vehicle parking code.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2	Relating to a public transit incentive surcharge.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The governing body of a city or county may adopt an ordinance imposing
5	a public transit incentive surcharge on the amount of any fine, fee or other charge imposed
6	for violation of any section of the respective city's or county's motor vehicle parking code.
7	(2) The surcharge may be imposed in an amount not to exceed 30 percent of the amount
8	of the fine, fee or other charge.
9	(3) The surcharge shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the fine,
10	fee or other charge.
11	(4) The surcharge may be contested in the same manner as the fine, fee or other charge.
