House Bill 2747

Sponsored by Representative HUDSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would tell the DOC to provide all adults in custody access to some online education. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.1).

Requires the Department of Corrections to provide adults in custody at all department institutions access to specific online educational programs.

- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 SECTION 1. ORS 421.074 is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 421.
 - **SECTION 2.** ORS 421.074 is amended to read:
- 7 421.074. (1) No later than September 1, [2023] **2026**, the Department of Corrections shall ensure
- 8 that adults in custody in [the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility and the Snake River Correctional
- 9 Institution] all department institutions have online access to:
- 10 (a) The adult basic skills development program described in ORS 421.084;
 - (b) The professional and technical program described in ORS 421.081; and
 - (c) Education programs that provide college credit, a college degree, a college certification, an industry-recognized certification or license or an apprenticeship.
 - (2) Nothing in this section establishes a legally enforceable right to online access to the programs described in this section for adults in custody.
 - (3) The department shall adopt any rules necessary for establishing program eligibility and participation criteria for online access for adults in custody.
 - <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.
